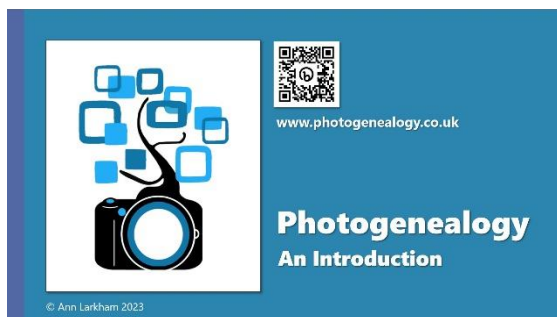




A lot has happened at Photogenealogy HQ since the last newsletter...

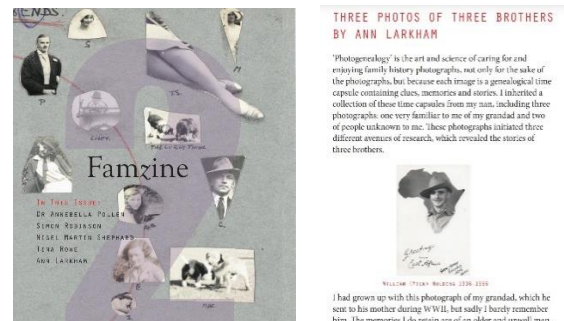
Articles
